Spousal & Child Diversions

I know many of you are travelling down as a family or with your significant other. Here are a few distractions they may wish to check out whilst you are up to your eyeballs in fibrous nirvana.

Marine Parade – Has seen a massive overhaul in the past 12 months. From Ocean Spa all the way down to the Aquarium, make sure you see the new viewing platform giving you some of the best views of the Bay.

National Aquarium of NZ: - Even if you have been before, this gem on Marine Parade is worth a repeat visit. The new penguin recovery sanctuary is now open, the Prehistoric room is fabulous & you always get to see the Kiwi (check out their <u>website</u> for feeding times)

Ocean Spa: - Pack your togs as Napier famous <u>Ocean Spa</u>, just a 15 minute walk around the waterfront on the Rotary Pathway on Marine Parade, has hot pools which are very family friendly. It is also the perfect place to visit after a long day stitching at KAN.

Spriggs Park & Marine Parade Playgrounds: - Spriggs park is the beachfront playground, just a few minutes' walk along the pathway (towards the Port) from the KAN Venue at East Pier. It's a great place to let the kids let off stream if you are staying nearby. If you want to experience a larger playground, which is fully fenced (great if you have a wee escape artist), the Marine Parade playground is the play for you. It's just before the National Aquarium on Marine Parade. Catch the Hopper bus from Ahuriri into town & the playground is about a 7 minute walk from the Napier i-site.

The MTG: - Napier newly revamped museum, theatre & gallery. It's just across the road and a 100m down from Ocean Spa. A perfect place to absorb some of the Napier Deco history & culture. Have a look on their <u>website</u> to see what attractions are available.

The Globe Theatre – Ahuriri's own boutique cinema situated in the heart of the Crown Hotel complex. It show's a mix of current block busters and arthouse films, The Globe is a comfortable 45 seat cinema that allows you to escape for a few hours. View coming attractions <u>here</u>.

HB Farmers Market – Is held in Napier on Saturday mornings in Clive Square (just over the hill from Ahuriri) or at the Hastings Showgrounds on Sunday. More info here

- Yarn; just in case you wish to play around with your stitch patterns
- Needles: size relevant to your yarn
- Cable needles, stitch markers, tape measure; your usual collection of necessary notions

- 3.25mm needles to knit with your choice of straights or circs, it will be not many stitches so you won't need a long needle
- A smaller, eg 2.25mm, dpn or circ needle
- 2 or more locking stitch markers
- darning needle
- Scissors
- Pen and paper for notes

Colours that Sing!

- Yarn for swatching (different colours, but of a similar weight)
- Needles to match their yarn

I will have a pile of fingering weight available for swatching - people are welcome to use this, and it would be well suited to 2.75mm- 3.25mm needles.

Bundled in Brioche

Class Requirements

- 3.5 to 4 mm needles circular needle or long dpns
- One light and one dark colour yarn dk or worsted weight wool
- Some locking stitch markers
- Crochet hook to pick up dropped stitches

Continental Knitting (R18 - may contain coarse language)

Class Requirements

- Standard knit kit
- DK yarn
- 4mm needles to practice with.

Darn It! Mending and Repairing Hand knits

Tutor: Georgie Nicolson - Tikki Knits

Class Requirements

Please bring to class a blocked swatch measuring approximately 30cm by 30cm in a light coloured DK/8ply yarn to practise techniques on

- Tapestry needle
- Spare DK/8ply weight yarn in contrasting colours
- Sewing needle and thread
- Darning mushroom or egg (not essential but handy: if your kids have wooden play food just nick one of their eggs or apples ;))

Bring along any knitted garments that require mending so we can look at how to approach these. If you fear something has been moth damaged, please contact me first so we can discuss pre-treatment for the class.

It's A Wrap!

Tutor: Morag McKenzie

Class Requirements

- Yarn and needles for swatches.
- 4ply and 3.25mm 4.00mm needles ideal. But feel free to bring scraps of lace too if you wish to examine the difference yarn makes to a design. You won't need a lot of yarn, 25g will be plenty, use up scraps if you have them.
- Circular needles are ideal (60cm or 80cm) straights can be used but don't allow you to easily examine the shape you are making as you work.
- Pen and paper, pencil and eraser
- Reading glasses if you need them.
- Your usual knit kit (scissors, markers, etc)

Sew free Modular Knitting

Class Requirements

- DK yarn in several light colours
- 4mm needles interchangeable, circs or straights
- Small, eg 2.25-3mm, DPN or circ needle
- Scissors
- Locking Stitch Markers or coilless safety pins
- Pen and paper for notes

The Shortest Stitch

Class Requirements

- 50 grams of 8ply/DK weight, light coloured, tightly spun WOOL (SKEINZ Vintage is a good go-to option)
- Crochet Hooks ranging from 4.5mm to 6.5 mm to allow you to experiment with stitch density
- Glasses and a pen if you usually require them for reading and writing or crocheting

Silver Lining Fingerless Gloves
