Class Requirements

Many class tutors have reached out already with requirement lists.

We suggest that to be completely prepared if you are attending classes you make sure you bring with you

- Basic notions kit: Including Scissors, wool needles, stitch markers, tape measure
- Basic Knit Kit: Two yarns with appropriate needle sizes (ie DK with 4mm/4.5mm)
- Basic Crochet Kit: Two yarns with appropriate hook sizes (ie DK with 4.5mm/5mm)
- If you have yarn leftovers from projects - bring them along
- Note Taking items: Tablet, notebook, smartphone - whatever suits.

Tunisian crochet

- Cotton yarn 8 or 10 ply 2 different colours or more
- Tunisian crochet hooks 4.5mm or 5mm
- Lockable stitch marker

Magic Marl knitting

- Assorted yarns in a variety of colours, weights and textures - whatever you have in stash
- Small balls left over from projects are ideal for this class
- Assorted knitting needle sizes

Give a Gnome a Home

- Set of 3.5mm or 3.75mm dpns
- Crochet hook in 3 - 3.5mm range
- 30gm each of 3 different coloured DK yarn for Hat, Body, Beard.

Class Requirements

Knit 2 Fit classes + Masterclass

- A blocked swatch (approx 6" x 6") in DK yarn, knitted in stocking-stitch on 4mm needles (preferably in the round);
- Pen or pencil
- Tape measure AND ruler
- Calculator (your phone will probably have one on it).

Homework

Before class you'll need to find some DK yarn (about 20 g in total) and knit a gauge swatch in stocking-stitch with 4mm needles. Ideally you'll knit your swatch in the round but if you're not ready to try that, just do a regular flat swatch, about 6" by 6". When you're done, soak and lay your swatch out to dry naturally. It might pay to knit your swatch a few days before the class so you've got time to block it and get it dry. *(If you run out of time, steam it with an iron instead. It's not quite as good but it'll do the trick).*

Confused about swatching? Don't fret - we'll talk about swatching in the class, but in the meantime, have a read of this article from my mini-mag all about swatching:

Colour Confidence

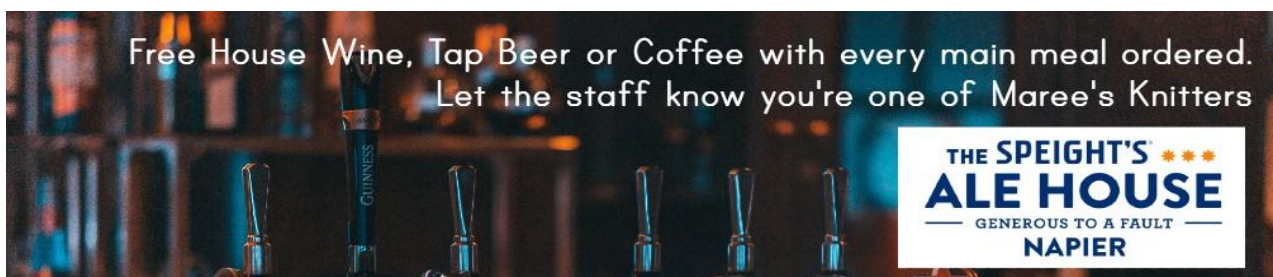
- Bring along a **previously finished project** where either you particularly loved/disliked the colours on you. Let's have a show and tell!

- 4 or 5mm hook

Crochet for the Home

- Small crochet hook - 1.5mm - 2mm (SkeinZ stocks 2mm hooks)

Tutor - Nanette Cormack

Masterclass 2.0

- Small amounts of DK yarn in several different colours
- Size 4mm knitting needles
- Darning needle & Scissors

Beatrix Bunny

- Approx 50g sock/fingering/4 ply yarn (striped or patterned yarn looks amazing on the bunny)
- 2.25mm dpns

Lace and Beads

- Around 50g 4 ply yarn
- Around 7g of size 6/0 round seed beads (approx 4mm bead, 1.5mm internal hole)
- Waxed dental floss

If your class has not been mentioned here it will be because the tutor has already reached out to you directly with all the information you need to know OR the requirements are within what we suggest you bring (see below)

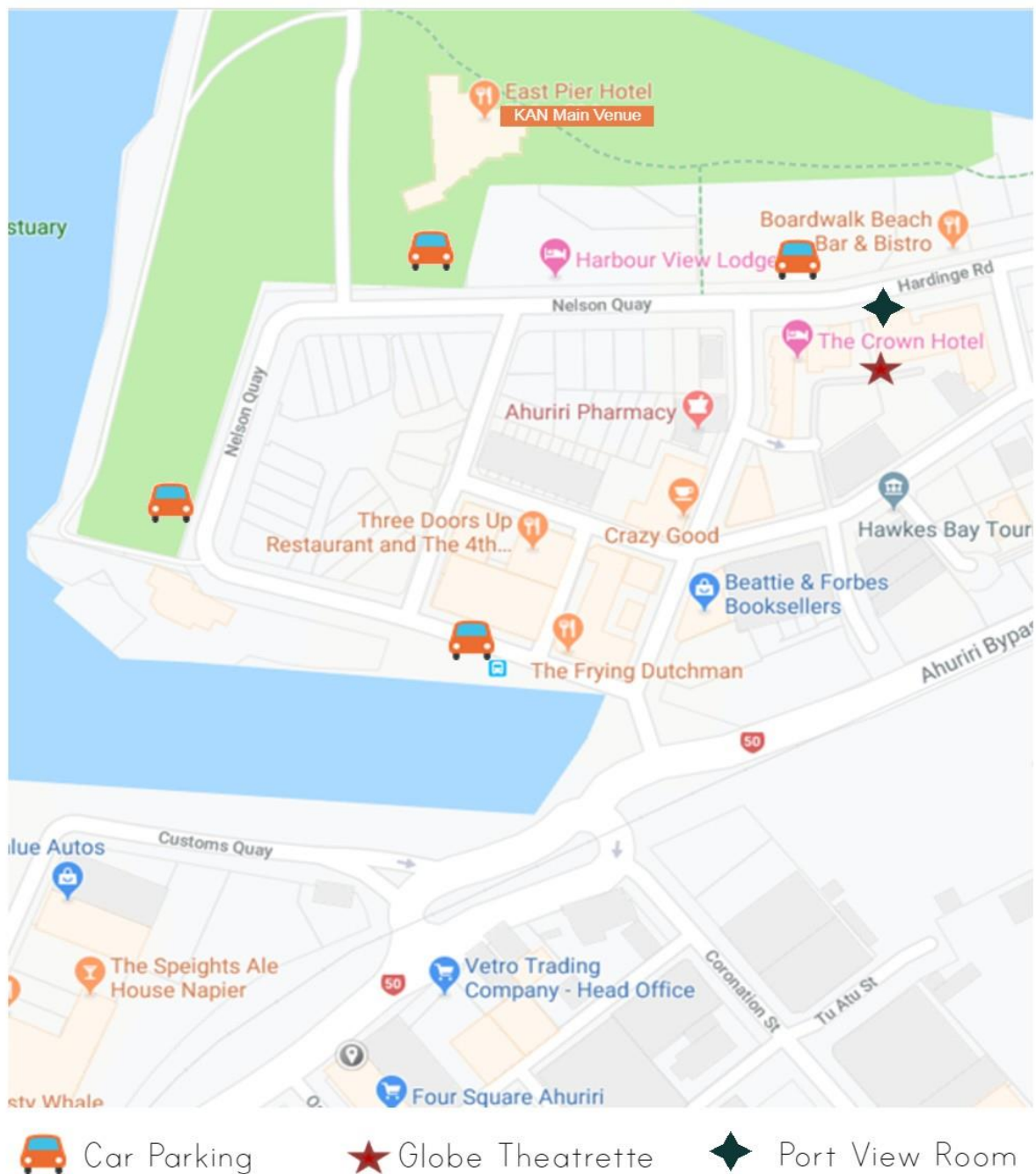

Useful Info on Ahuriri

Car Parking

This can be premium, especially in the weekends. The public car parks are indicated on the map.

Make sure you check the time allocated in these areas to ensure no surprising parking tickets.

ATM

This is located outside Beattie & Forbes. Cash facilities will be available at the KAN hot desk at East Pier (\$1 withdrawal fee applies)

Need time out?

If you need to escape the hubbub of East Pier and have a little quiet time out, there are seating areas outside Ahuriri Pharmacy, the Box & Crazy Good.

Beattie and Forbes also have a couch and encourage you to grab a coffee and hide with your knitting in store.

Need a Supermarket?

Our amazing Ahuriri 4Square is just a short walk from the central Village. It has a vast selection in store if you feel like self-catering. It also has a surprisingly good beer and wine selection.

Foodies Paradise.

Vetro Trading Company is the flagship store of this incredible nationwide deli wholesaler, it is located in a courtyard with Gourmet Direct Meats and Picnic artisan foods.

Great Wines of Hawkes Bay

Opposite the 4Square is The Urban Winery, home of Tony Bish Wines, some stylish craft beers and great tapa's menu. Or if you'd prefer to grab a really great bottle of wine to have with your dinner or takeaway, the call in and see the team at Cellar Ahuriri, nestled to the left of Ahuriri Pharmacy.

Napier City CBD

This is a brisk 20 minute walk around the boardwalk on the foreshore, past the Port into town.

Alternatively you can catch the #15 Go Bus - the fare is \$3.60 to the driver & route details are here (<https://www.gobay.co.nz/timetable/route-15>)

WiFi

We have free WiFi at East Pier. There is also free public WiFi available at Spriggs Park immediately adjacent to the Boardwalk Bar & Bistro

Useful Info if Travelling with Family

I know many of you are travelling down as a family or with your significant other. Here are a few distractions they may wish to check out whilst you are up to your eyeballs in fibrous nirvana.

Marine Parade – Has seen a massive overhaul in the past several years. From Ocean Spa all the way down to the Aquarium, make sure you see the new viewing platform giving you some of the best views of the Bay, the kids will love Bay Skate, Lick This ice-cream parlour and the walking paths.

National Aquarium of NZ: – Even if you have been before, this gem on Marine Parade is worth a repeat visit. The penguin recovery sanctuary is now open, the penguin rescue room is fabulous & you always get to see the Kiwi (check out their [website](#) for feeding times)

Ocean Spa: – Pack your togs as Napier famous [Ocean Spa](#), just a 15 minute walk around the waterfront on the Rotary Pathway on Marine Parade, has hot pools which are very family friendly. It is also the perfect place to visit after a long day stitching at KAN.

Spriggs Park & Marine Parade Playgrounds: – Spriggs park is the beachfront playground, just a few minutes' walk along the pathway (towards the Port) from the KAN Venue at East Pier. It's a great place to let the kids let off steam if you are staying nearby. If you want to experience a larger playground, which is fully fenced (great if you have a wee escape artist), the Marine Parade playground is the play for you. It's just before the National Aquarium on Marine Parade. Catch the Hopper bus from Ahuriri into town & the playground is about a 7 minute walk from the Napier i-site.

Hire a Bike: – There are two great bike hire companies, to help get you on two wheels and exploring the extensive range of cycleways we have in the Bay. Takako Trails is situated in the Ahuriri Village and Fish Bike in on Marine Parade, next to Ocean Spa.

The Globe Theatre – Ahuriri's own boutique cinema situated in the heart of the Crown Hotel complex. It shows a mix of current block busters and arthouse films, The Globe is a comfortable 45 seat cinema that allows you to escape for a few hours. View coming attractions [here](#).

HB Farmers Market – Is held in Napier on Saturday mornings in Clive Square (just over the hill from Ahuriri) or at the Hastings Showgrounds on Sunday. More info [here](#)
